**Speed Control and Lane Position** are vital to safety behind the wheel. Maintaining appropriate speed involves adjustments with the accelerator and brake. Maintaining appropriate lane position involves making steering adjustments while searching. These adjustments can be challenging and change with each driving situation.

Our recommendation for you is to...

- Slow to 10 MPH before a turn, remain on the brake until  $\frac{1}{2}$  way, then accelerate.
- Continue practicing! Your skills are on pace with your experience level.
